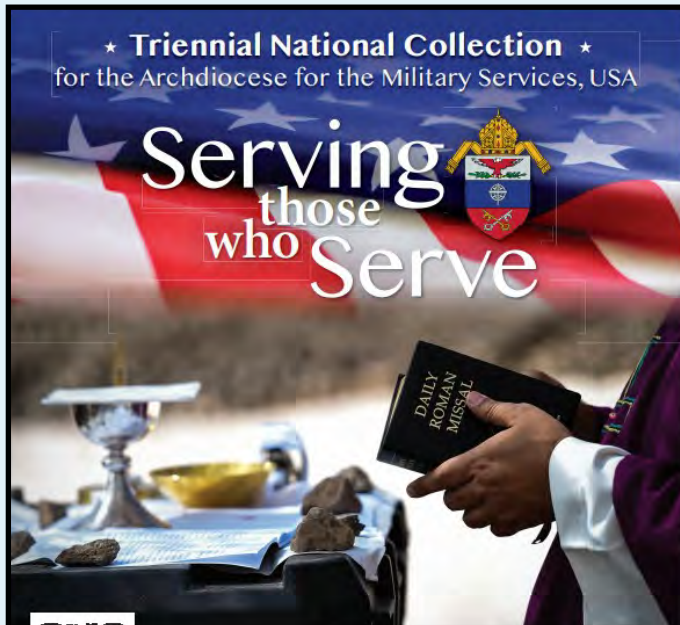


Second Collection Next Weekend November 8 and 9 For the Military Services

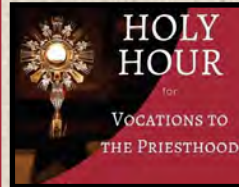

He saw her as the first disciple of Jesus and a pilgrim of hope who lived her faith by humbly waiting on and serving God ("I am the handmaid of the Lord" – Luke 1:38). Pope Francis emphasized that the Virgin Mary leads us to her Son, who is the hope that never disappoints.

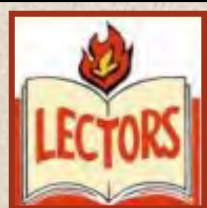

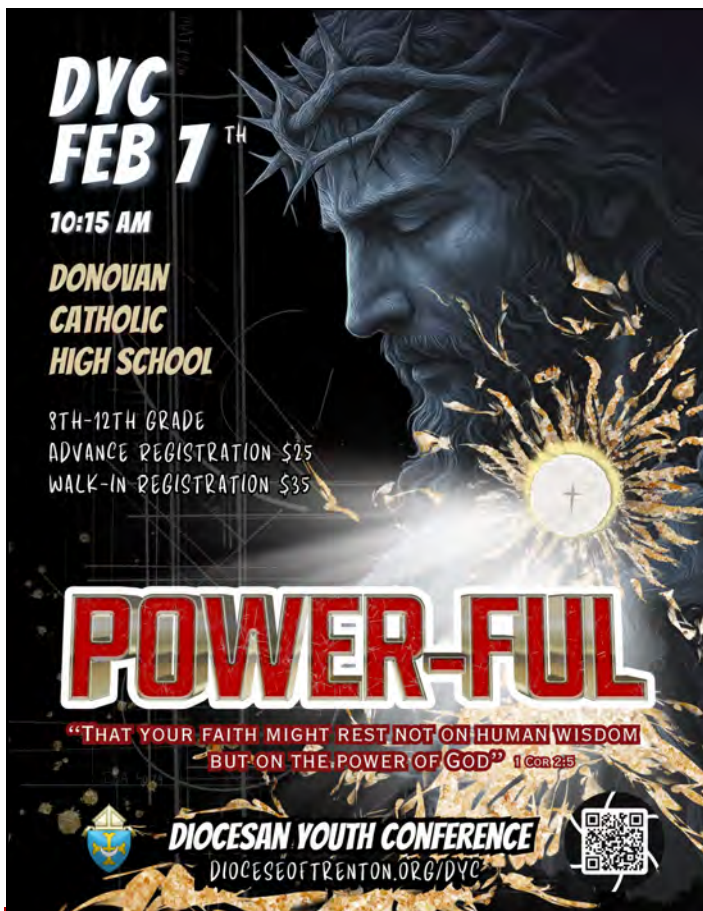

P.S. "OCIA" and "Order of Christian Initiation for Adults" is the fairly new name for religious instruction that many of us knew (until recently) as "RCIA" and the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults."



Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community.

Some people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Registering as parishioners requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish by contacting the parish business office. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility and qualification letter from the pastor, and getting donation statements for your income tax returns. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish and of the Church.
