

Communion Visits; Confession Visits; Anointing of the Sick



Please keep in mind that the parish priests and our lay Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist are available and eager to bring Communion to Ministers parishioners who are in the hospital (nursing homes, assist-

ed living facilities, rehab centers, and hospices, too) and to parishioners who are at home but unable to get to

church. Please contact Mary Valan at the parish office to make arrangements. Hospitals and other healthcare facilities generally do not notify the parish office regarding their Catholic patients who desire to receive Sacraments. And so it falls to the patient herself/himself or to a family member or friend to contact the parish office to make the request. The parish priests will also very gladly make a hospital visit or



home visit to hear a Confession and/or administer the Sacrament of the Sick ("Anointing of the Sick") in addition to bringing Holy Communion. Please remember to contact the parish office to make these arrangements. Thank you.

And First Friday Mass will also be celebrated at 5:30 p.m. on Friday, January 2 with Confessions following that 5:30 Mass until 6:30 p.m. All are welcome.

Please join us for a Children's Rosary on Sunday, January 11 after the 10:00 a.m. Mass at St. Michael's Church.






